Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Rusty Eddy with members Greg Barnett and Tom Heidenwirth present. Also present were Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, Deb Wangsness, Assistant Engineer Dave Scanlan, Together 4 Families Shawna Lebeck and Recorder Janice Jacobs.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION #403-20

WHEREAS, it is desired to make appropriations for each of the different officers and departments for the year beginning July 1, 2019, in accordance with section 331.434, subsection 6, Code of Iowa, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1. The amount itemized by fund and by department or office on the following schedule are hereby appropriated from the resources of each fund so itemized, to the department or office listed in the first column on the same line of the following schedule.

Section 2. Subject to the provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under section 1, shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or incur obligations from the itemized fund, effective July 1, 2019.

Section 3. In accordance with section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expend or contract to expend any money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amount appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

Section 4. If any time during the 2019-2020 budget year the auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

Section 5. The auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amount charged thereto and the unencumbered balance. The auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers monthly during the 2019-2020 budget year.

Section 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2020.

**RESOLUTION FOR INTERFUND OPERATING TRANSFER # 404-20
General Basic/Rural Services Funds to Secondary Roads Fund**

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the auditor to periodically transfer sums from the general basic and rural services basic funds to the secondary road fund during the 2019/2020 budget year, and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.429, Code of Iowa, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1. The total maximum transfer from the general basic fund to the secondary road fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, shall not exceed the sum of \$150,000.00; and the total maximum transfer from the rural services basic fund to the secondary road fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, shall not exceed the sum of \$1,800,000.00.

Section 2. After being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, mobile home taxes, military service tax credit, or delinquent taxes paid for prior years to the general basic or rural services basic fund, the auditor shall order a transfer from said fund to secondary road fund.

Section 3. The amount of the transfer required by section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment made under section 2, to the general basic or rural services basic fund, respectively, multiplied by the ratio of said fund's total maximum transfer to the secondary road fund, to the sum of said fund's total current property tax levy, total mobile home taxes, total military service tax credits, and total delinquent taxes paid for prior years.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 and 3 of this resolution, total transfers to the secondary road fund shall not exceed the amount specified in section 1.

Section 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 and 3, the amount of any transfer shall not exceed available funds balances in the transferring fund.

Section 6. The auditor is directed to correct her books when said operating transfers are made and to notify the treasurer and the county engineer of the amount of said transfers.

RESOLUTION #928

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN UPDATED OFFICIAL COUNTY SEAL THAT IS
TO BE USED ON ALL OFFICIAL BALLOTS OF THE COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, HF652 sets new requirements for placing the county seal on ballots and removes the facsimile signature of the County Commissioner of Elections (County Auditor) from the ballots.

WHEREAS, House File 652, approved earlier this year, amended Iowa Code §43.36, §49.51, and §49.57 by removing the current requirement in these sections to include a facsimile of the signature of the County Commissioner of Elections (County Auditor) on the ballots subject to these statutes. These bills also added a requirement that the county seal of the county be placed on the ballots provided for in these statutes. HF652 also amended Iowa Code §49.82 to provide a general bar on placing the name or signature of the Commissioner of Elections on a ballot except where the Commissioner is listed as one of the candidates for election on the ballot.

WHEREAS, the specifications for the county seal are provided by Iowa Code Section §331.552 (4) requiring the following: (1) the seal to be an impression seal (2) on the seal shall be (a) the name of the county, (b) the words "county" and "treasurer" which may be abbreviated, (c) the word "Iowa".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Butler County Board of Supervisors hereby approve adopting an updated Official County Seal to be used on the official ballots of the county with the specifications for the county seal as provided by Iowa Code Section §331.552 (4).
