Riherd provided an engineer update regarding the contracts for local bridges and the asphalt work on T16 through Dumont. Riherd stated that there would be about 11 subcontractors on the T16 project. Mathy Construction is the primary contractor, PCI and Boulder have some concrete work. They are on schedule to start next week on the deck overlays on T-25. Started to notify some of the road users. Riherd will try to get something on the radio to notify the public of the upcoming road closures. Riherd shared information regarding a pavement marking project for centerlines throughout the county and edge lining for primarily south of Highway 3. Bids were a range of prices and Kam Line Highway Markings was selected. The goal is to get back to a road lining schedule being half and half. 2 trucks have been ordered to stay ahead of the tariffs, and they are working on a DARA grant to help with part of the purchase of Chassis related to Volkswagen emissions settlement several years ago.
