Resolution setting public hearing - proposed road vacation (Pearl Avenue)

WHEREAS, the Butler County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Code of Iowa Chapter 306.10 to establish, alter or vacate roads or highways under their jurisdiction, and		
WHEREAS, The Board has received a petition, signed by all adjoining landowners, requesting that a portion of Pearl Avenue be vacated and closed to the public; and		
WHEREAS, an engineering review indicates that it is in the public's interest to vacate and close a portion of Pearl Avenue in Section 27 Dayton Township lying NORTH of the Northwest corner of Parcel "D" (Inst. No. 2011-2887) in Lot 2 of the Subdivision of W ½ SE ¼ and SE ¼ SE ¼ (Book A Pages 205-206), and SOUTH of the thread of the Shell Rock River; and		
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that a hearing on the proposed road vacation be held in the Board Room, Butler County Courthouse, Allison, Iowa at		
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Notice of Hearing shall be published in the official county newspapers and be sent by Certified Mail to all adjoining property owners and any utility companies with facilities along said roads.
