WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has approved the updated FY22 Iowa DOT Secondary Roads Budget;

WHEREAS, the FY22 County Budget is being updated to reflect the changes in the FY22 Iowa DOT Secondary Road Budget;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors to re-appropriate the following amounts to be expended in various categories and line items within the Roads and Transportation budget from which they are used for Fiscal Year 2022.

<u>Expenditure</u>	<u>FY22 Original Appropriation</u>	<u>FY22 Reappropriated</u>	<u>Net Change</u>
7100 – Bridges & Culverts	\$340,000	\$590,000	\$250,000
7110 – Roads	\$2,450,000	\$2,650,000	\$200,000
7200 – New Equipment	\$350,000	\$100,000	(\$250,000)
7230 – Buildings	\$300,000	\$100,000	(\$200,000)

The above amounts do not increase tax askings for the fiscal year.


