

Environmental Health report to the Board of Health

22-23 Fiscal Year Well Program:

Water tests: 46 (compared to 30 at this time last fiscal year)

Well permits: 5 (8 last fiscal year)

Well closings: 5 (4 last fiscal year)

Rehabilitated: 2 rehabs (3 last fiscal year)

Grant amount is \$50,505 this fiscal year and there is approximately \$41,125.73 remaining.

Septic

Permits: I issued 92 permits so far this year compared to 70 permits at this time last year. *(I'd be at 68 permits without the water infrastructure grant)*

28 for New Construction, 17 failing/illegally discharging, 21 for ToFT, 24 for the water infrastructure grant and 2 for camper/tiny home (recreational).

There still haven't been any more approvals for the wastewater grant since the last meeting or updates on how long to expect approval to take place. The 6 systems that were approved have been installed and 2 have been reimbursed so far.

Seasonal Help

I have hired Becky Schrage for the seasonal help position with potential to turn into a more permanent, part-time position this spring. She will start October 17th.
