

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the constitutional amendment establishing home rule for county government was adopted by the people of the State of Iowa on November 8, 1978; and,

WHEREAS, the Iowa Supreme Court in defining the implementation of municipal home rule proclaimed in Green v. City of Cascade and Bechtel v. City of Des Moines that the "Dillon Rule" was reversed as soon as the people voted to adopt the constitutional amendment; and,

WHEREAS, implementation of county home rule will strengthen local government, lessening the chance of takeover by regional, state or federal government; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Butler County Board of Supervisors makes a public declaration, and through this resolution states its intention to adopt and implement home rule for our citizens and their county government.

PASSED by the Board of Supervisors and APPROVED this 17<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1981.
