

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. IV, No. 4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY MANURE INTO  
DITCHES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drain, direct, or channel any waste products, manure, offal, or other like noxious liquids from any lagoon, feed lot, confinement unit, or the like, into any County ditch, or onto any roadway or any other County property, or into any ditch where the County has an easement for road purposes. After notice to such person, entity, or agent, each separate day of such discharge shall be considered a separate violation.

2. PENALTIES.

A. CRIMINAL. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined up to \$100.00 or imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed thirty days, plus any legal costs or surcharges otherwise provided. Each continuing day of such a violation shall be considered a separate violation.


B. CIVIL. In addition to any criminal penalties, or in lieu of any criminal penalties, the County may recover the reasonable and necessary costs to remove or alter any illegal alterations, or the cost of removing any illegally discharged waste products.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on January 4, 1988.
