Meeting called to order at 9:00 A.M. by Rusty Eddy with members Wayne Dralle and Greg Barnett present. Moved by Dralle, second by Barnett to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motioned by Barnett, second by Dralle to approve November 18th minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

No public comment was received.

Motioned by Barnett, second by Dralle to open Public Hearing on FY26 Budget Amendment #1. Auditor Leslie Groen explained the budget amendment items. After no additional comments, it was motioned by Dralle, second by Barnett, to close the public hearing. All ayes. Motion carried.

EMS update, Kari Coates the Board with the pending Certificate of Registration regarding the Iowa Controlled Substances Act for the Advanced Paramedics. Coates mentioned began researching a Crisis K-9 being implemented in the future and informed them that would entail someone being an approved handler. She also provided information on a Butler County EMS Education Day scheduled for January 24th in Parkersburg. The full agenda is still being decided, and she will update Board on the public attendance portion. Eddy asked if she had a current list or county of EMS volunteers. Coates did not have a current number but felt we were maintaining existing numbers.

Coates informed the Board a Lucas Device needed repairs and explained a three-year service contract through Stryker ProCare Services would take care of the repairs. The annual cost was \$1600 per device, and we have three devices. Motioned by Barnett, second by Dralle to approve authorizing Coates to sign the contract. All ayes. Motioned carried.

Leslie Groen, Auditor, informed the Board of the upcoming ISAC 99-County Tour with the Butler County Employee Open House scheduled for December 9th from 9:30 to 11:30.

During Engineer's update Riherd shared updates on T16 in Dumont, mentioned residents' concerns regarding field mud and manure on roads and the Secondary Roads crew are preparing for snow over the weekend.

Motioned by Barnett, second by Dralle to approve claims. All ayes. Motion carried.

Board acknowledged receipt of Manure Management Plan Forms for M&M Construction #64429, Klingenberg #59616, Steve Schmidt #59347, Retexe, LLC #64529, David Brinkman #58474, DC Farms #64608, and Harvest Moon Farms, LLC #69157.

Motioned by Barnett, second by Dralle to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:31 A.M. to December 2, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. All ayes. Motion carried.
