**Resolution setting public hearing – proposed reclassification
of Orange Ave in Sec 28 Dayton TWP**

Moved by Heidenwirth and seconded by Eddy to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The Butler County Board of Supervisors desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in Butler County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance and access by means of a gate or barrier; and

WHEREAS, The Board is empowered under authority of the Code of Iowa Chapter 309.57 to specify level of maintenance and access to certain roads within the County as Area Level Service “C” roads; and

WHEREAS, The Board has received a petition, signed by all adjoining landowners, requesting that:

That portion of Orange Ave commencing 0.25 miles East of the NW corner Sec 28, T-93N, R16W (Dayton Twp) thence running South 0.55 miles.

be reclassified from an Area Level Service “B” to Area Level Service “C”

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that a hearing on the proposed reclassification be held in the Emergency Operations Center, Butler County Courthouse, Allison, Iowa at 9:00 A.M., Tuesday, June 14th, 2022.


