CREATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, Butler County is eligible for receiving the National Opioid Settlement Plan funding and;

WHEREAS, a separate accounting of the revenues and expenses for this funding source is desired by local governments for tracking of revenue and expenditures to provide a detailed accounting of the use of funds.

WHEREAS, a new fund will be created called "Local Government Opioid Abatement Fund", Fund 0032, for the purpose of accounting for the revenue and expenses received from the National Opioid Settlement.

WHEREAS, Butler County will create revenue and expense accounts as needed, within Fund 0032, for tracking the use of these funds.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that a new fund will be created called "Local Government Opioid Abatement Fund", Fund 0032, for the purpose of accounting for the revenue and expenses received from the National Opioid Settlement. The budgetary fund shall be subject to standard county accounting practices and policies.
