

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. IV, No. 5

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF ANY JUNK OR TRASH ON
PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, DITCHES OR COUNTY PROPERTY

1. No person shall throw, dump, deposit, or otherwise leave any trash, junk, debris, rocks, boulders, refuse, manure or other like material on any public highway or roadway within Butler County or in any adjacent ditches, right of way, or on any other county property, or on property where Butler County or the State of Iowa has an easement for road purposes, or other right of way.

2. DEFINITIONS:

A. Debris, refuse or trash shall mean any litter, waste, garbage, rubbish, ashes, or other like substances.

B. Junk shall include, in addition to the above, any wrecked, salvaged or junked automobiles, machinery, used tires, batteries or lumber, or other like substances.


C. Manure shall include any animal waste products hauled on any vehicle from one location to another, but shall not include animal waste products deposited by any animals being transported, driven, or led from one location to another.

3. PENALTIES. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined up to \$100.00 or imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed thirty days, plus any legal costs or surcharges otherwise provided. Each continuing day of such a violation shall be considered a separate violation.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on January 4, 1988.
